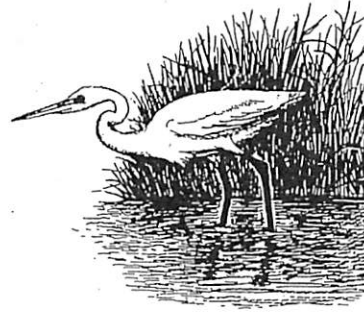


Liberty State Park's location along the Atlantic Flyway makes it an important habitat for many species of birds.

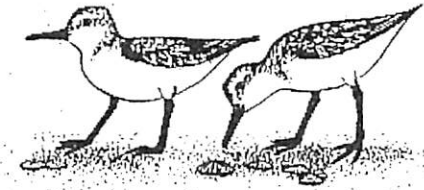

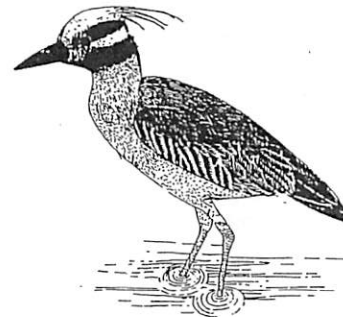

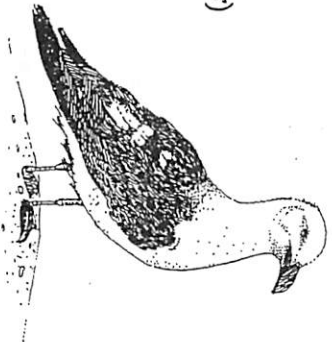

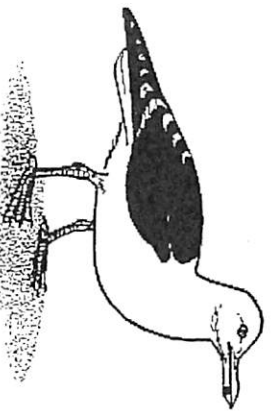

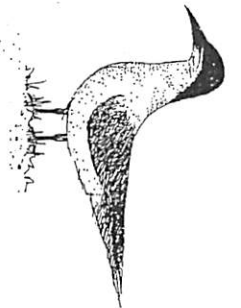

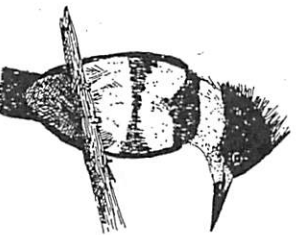

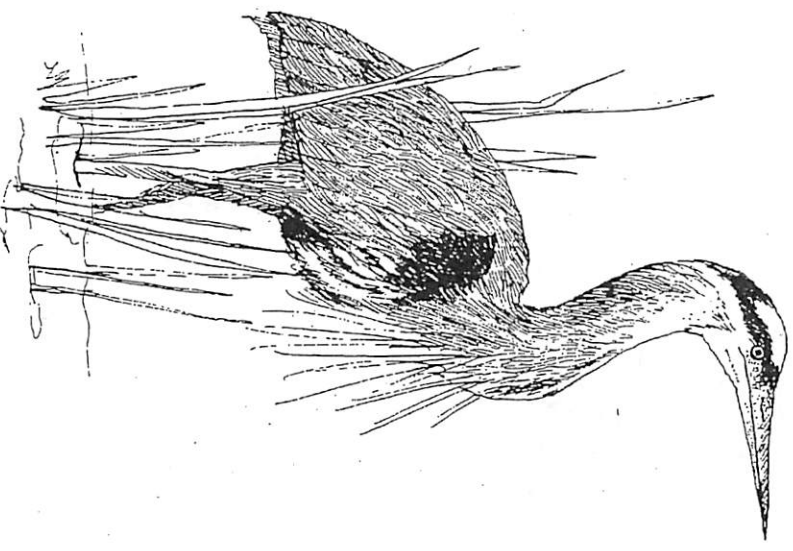
