STATUE OF LIBERTY & LIBERTY ISLAND

- Take a Statue of Liberty Pedestal Tour or walk up to the crown! Check out the museum, which houses the original torch!

ELLIS ISLAND

- The ferry will take you to Ellis Island - the place where 12 million immigrants took their first steps on American soil. Visitors can see historical artifacts and

head to the American Family Immigration History Center to look up relatives.

CENTRAL RAILROAD TERMINAL

- Take a walk through the historic Central Railroad of New Jersey terminal that was part of the hub for the immigration for northern, southern, and eastern Europeans, among others, into the United States.

EMPTY SKY 9/11 MEMORIAL

- Powerful memorial in Liberty State Park, which was designed to commemorate the more than 700 New Jersey residents lost during the 9/11 tragedy.

There are hands-on exhibits and experiences in the fields of science, technology, engineering and mathematics for all ages. One exhibit is the Jennifer Chalsty Planetarium - the Western Hemisphere's biggest planetarium. There are 12 museum exhibition halls, a giant aquarium, 3D Theatre, Giant Dome Theatre, and more. Recently they added the Titanic Artifact Museum. Some other

key exhibits include the Touch Tunnel, Dino Dig Adventure, Family Science Camp, LSC After Dark, and more!
